### **BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE/BOARD MEETING MINUTES** **Tuesday July 28, 2015** **Hidden Lake Clubhouse, West Hills**

The meeting was called to order at 6:58 PM by Reeyan Raynes, Acting Chair

Those in attendance were Steve Randall, Reeyan Raynes, Barry Seybert, Ron Sobel, Anthony Brosamle, Miguel Fernandez and Heidi Manning. A quorum was established.

The June 2015 minutes were approved as amended.

It was suggested that we obtain "SLOW DOWN" and "COMMUNITY VOLUNTEERS" signs to use during cleanups that could be mounted on A-frames that Ron Sobel would provide. Miguel offered to get bids for the signs. It was also suggested that we obtain four sandbags per banner sign to prevent it from blowing over.

Barry Seybert stated that he would like to see the property at Valley Circle & Indian Hill next to Shomrei Torah made into a park-like setting with plants and benches.

We discussed the success of the July 11<sup>th</sup> cleanup that went very well. Heidi Manning mentioned that she came to the site later that evening and did some additional work. The November 7<sup>th</sup> cleanup in conjunction with The Church at Rocky Peak and Pastor Moorehead's volunteers was discussed and the fact that we needed to come up with cleanup locations.

Tony Brosamle mentioned that he has designed a web page for the Beautification Committee and would share it with Elliot Maggin. Tony, Barry & Ron were to look into obtaining a letter from Councilmember Englander's office to distribute to homes that have unattended foliage where their block wall borders the sidewalk.

The Bell Canyon Creek Hiking/Equestrian Trail north of Castle Peak cleanup for weed and graffiti removal to be led by Reeyan Raynes, was scheduled for 8:00 A.M – 11:00 A.M. It was agreed that everyone would meet in the street in front of 24654 Woodglade Lane at 8:00 A.M.
