- 1. The MISSION of this Committee is to help establish a viable Cultural, Community & Senior Center in West Hills to serve the West San Fernando Valley.
- 2. This Committee consists of 9 members who are:

- 3. A quorum consists of <u>5</u> members.
- 4. Voting rights shall be afforded to Committee members Only.
- 5. Members of this Committee are to be appointed by the Committee Chair.
- 6. Officers of this Committee are to be appointed by the Committee Chair.
- 7. The Officers of this Committee are: Steve Randall (Chair) and Char Rothstein (Secretary).
- 8. The Secretary shall be responsible for taking minutes.
- 9. The writing and posting of the Agenda shall be the responsibility of <u>Steve Randall</u>.
- 10. Committee Members must not miss more than four (4) meetings in the previous 12 month period, or they may be removed as voting members by the Committee Chair.
- 11. The Committee's goals are to: 1) Investigate possible locations for a Center, 2) Investigate potential funding sources, 3) Determine Community support, and 4) Garner support from various community leaders and community stakeholders.
- 12. No officer of this committee or member of this committee shall make any representations to any agency on behalf of the committee without committee approval.
- 13. No officer of this committee or member of this committee shall make any representations to the Board on behalf of the committee without approval from the committee.
- 14. These rules may be amended at any regular meeting of the Cultural, Community and Senior Center Committee by a majority vote of the members present, assuming that there is a quorum.
- 15. This committee shall abide by the WHNC Code of Conduct. This code shall apply to all committee members, whether or not they are members of the WHNC Board.
- 16. The parliamentary process is to be governed by the most current edition of Rosenberg's Rules of Order.
- 17. This Committee will meet on the <u>3rd Tuesday of the month at 7:30 PM at Chaminade College</u> <u>Preparatory High School-Condon Center</u>, 23241 W. Cohasset Street, West Hills, CA 91304 unless there is a conflict that requires meeting at a different place, day or time.
