EPA is supporting the California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) and the Department of Energy (DOE) by providing radiological assessment equipment at the Santa Susana Field Lab (SSFL) site recently impacted by the Woolsey Fire near Simi Valley. EPA set up five air sampling stations that will provide radiological exposure data and air samples for laboratory analysis. The air samples collected from the monitors will be sent to EPA's National Analytical Radiation Environmental Laboratory in Alabama for analysis. Once data is analyzed, it will be provided to our agency partners including DOE, DTSC and the Woolsey Fire Unified Command to supplement its ongoing monitoring work at the site.
