To discuss fencing at the Highlander site

As we informed you recently, a feasibility study is currently under way for a potential project to be built at the Highlander site. That being a lengthy process, and mindful of neighbors' concerns with the old structures on the site, we went ahead and demolished those old structures right away, even though a determination has yet to be made as to what project would ultimately be built on the site.

As promised, now that demolition is complete, we are coming back to community to dialogue with neighbors about what type of provisional fencing (and/or related elements, if any) should be built on the site. This fencing, if any, will remain in place until it is determined what type of permanent project will be built at the site. Chief Facilities Executive Mark Hovatter will be on hand for this conversation with neighbors and community. Please join us.
