- 1. The meeting was called to order at 7:54 p.m.
- 2. Voting members present were Simone Best, Dan Brin, Steve Randall, Reeyan Raynes, Michael Teitelbaum and Brad Vanderhoof. Marge Brown, Alec Uzemeck, Tom Booth and Tony Brosamle were absent. Stakeholder Muriel Moorhead was present. Quorum was established.
- 3. Minutes were reviewed and approved unanimously with minor corrections.
- 4. Simone Best spoke about the Homeless Count on Tuesday January 24th. She mentioned that she attended a two hour training for the event and also informed the committee that the general media blitz will start this weekend for Los Angeles. She also said that there will be representatives from Councilmember Englander's office at our event. She also spoke briefly about the Measure S Town Hall being run by the Zoning & Planning Committee. She also thanked Dan Brin for his incredible work with the recent enewsletter on traffic safety. Lastly, Simone updated the committee on Spring Fest activities.
