Public comment is limited to 2 minutes per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of said committee.

<u>Notice to Paid Representatives</u> - If you are compensated to monitor, attend, or speak at this meeting, city law may require you to register as a lobbyist and report your activity.
