Committee Co-ChairAnthony Brosamle called the meeting to order at 7:42 PM. A quorum was established.

- 5. Ongoing Projects: The form to track approved traffic signal light installation progress will be a fillable pdf instead of the Google doc discussed in September. Faye suggested the Committee hold a pedestrian safety forum. Leila and other residents are working to involve more stakeholders in efforts to repave the streets in the Azul/Chatlake area. Olivia will work with the CD 12 office. Myrl stated the busses at Platt are mostly parking in the correct location. Brad said a stakeholder has requested a shade structure at that location. Dan said the same request has been made for the bus stop in front of the new restaurant at Fallbrook and Victory. Steve Kallen suggested requesting a 'your speed is' sign at least on a temporary basis to raise driver awareness.

- 7. CF 17-1143 Comprehensive Assessment/Streets Withdrawn from Public Use & Reinstatement Procedure: Olivia distributed a 'Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee Report' on the file dated ME 10/3/18. Olivia explained the Co-chairs are requesting a CIS in support if amended to explicitly mention a request for repaying of Azul and Chatlake.
