SPECIAL JOINT BOARD and STREETS & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE ONLINE AND TELEPHONIC MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, September 22, 2020

Revised September 29, 2020

Committee members in attendance: Anthony Scarce, Faye Barta, Thomas Booth, Dan Brin, Bonnie Klea, Heidi Manning, Steve Randall, Joan Trent, and Brad Vanderhoof.

Also in attendance: Aida Abkarians, Gil Solomon, Dave W. and Christina Walsh.

Committee Chair Anthony Scarce called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM. A quorum was established.

Numbers refer to agenda items.

Comments from the Chair: The Committee will now meet on the third Tuesday of the month.

Announcements: None.

Public Comments: Dave W. said his parents live just off Shoup on Sausalito and the alley is in really bad shape. The neighbors have been trying to get the paving repaired for years and the CD12 office has not helped. Dave has built a webpage to show the damage.

1. Discussion and Possible Approval of Minutes from the August 25th, 2020 Streets and Transportation Committee Meeting: The minutes were approved.
2. Discussion and Possible Action: on Stop Signs at Victory Blvd. and Pat Ave. (Woodland Hills/West Hills border): As the stakeholder was not present the Chair tabled this item until October.
3. Discussion and Possible Action: on Pedestrian Flags: Heidi contacted a couple of Cub Scout troops and they seem interested. Aida has placed the item on the WHNC Youth and Education Committee agenda. They would focus on intersections near schools. Anthony has contacted Haynes Street Elementary and St. Bernardine. Thomas asked if there are any studies verifying a safety benefit from the flags.
4. Discussion and Possible Action: on Utility Box Art Project: Anthony gave an update – DOT approval is needed; Eric Moody sent a letter from CD12 a week ago and awaiting a response. Ms. Christina Walsh presented a proposal to have an artwork project dedicated to the ‘Burro Flats Cultural District’ at Roscoe and Valley Circle. She would like to see Native American artists do the painting. The North Hollywood subway station has artwork on this theme. www.BurroFlats.org

Dan moved to recommend approval of artwork at Roscoe and Valley Circle.
The motion was approved with a unanimous vote.
