JOINT BOARD and STREETS & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE ONLINE AND TELEPHONIC MEETING MINUTES

Committee Co-chair Anthony Scearce called the meeting to order at 7:31 PM. A quorum was established.

Comments from the Co-Chair(s): Regarding the Chaminade expansion, Anthony said this committee will only deal with parking and traffic concerns.

Numbers refer to agenda items.

1. Traffic and Parking related to the Chaminade Proposed Expansion:

Brad Rosenheim identified himself as a lobbyist registered with the City of Los Angeles.

Armen Hovanessian said there are two main parts to the traffic plan analysis.

- 1. Impact on vehicle miles travelled or trips
- 2. Local traffic circulation and safety issues

DOT has mandated study of four intersections

- 1. Woodlake and Saticoy
- 2. Woodlake and Cohasset
- 3. Saticoy and Keswick
- 4. Platt and Cohasset

No increase in number of trips is anticipated because student enrollment is not increasing.

Pick-up and drop-off locations stay the same with cars entering on Chaminade and exiting onto Keswick.

The school is asking for parking restrictions next to the campus on the east side of Chaminade and the north side of Cohasset.

Restrictions would be from 6-9 Am and @-5 PM on school days.

The North Campus will have 101 parking spaces which will be a net increase of about 40 spaces over what the school currently has. The analysis will review the Woodlake and Saticoy intersection for a possible traffic signal.

2. Appointing member(s) to lead the compilation of sidewalks in West Hills that need repair: Anthony asked committee members to record exact addresses where sidewalks are in need of repair and take pictures. Myrl read a letter from CD12 (Kathy Lettieri) saying the City Council passed an ordinance to define a process for prioritizing sidewalk repair. Myrl will take the lead compiling a list of locations. Faye will canvass the Highlander neighborhood. Bob will survey his neighborhood. Steve has already sent Anthony locations.

Committee Co-chair Anthony Scearce adjourned the meeting at 8:51 PM.

The next meeting of this committee is TBD depending on the return to in-person meetings.
