#### **Old Business**

- 1. Discussion and update on LAFD C.E.R.T. training slated for October.
  - A location was still not identified. Several locations are being looked at, e.g., De Toledo, Temples and Churches, etc.

#### **New Business**

1. Discussion and possible action on a request for Neighborhood Watch signs from Jessica Fuentes Jessica presented a map of her neighborhood next to the West Hills hospital. She has been in contact with SLO Kari of the LAPD Topanga Station. They had the first meeting in the cul-de-sac. There have been incidents of drinking, tailgating and drug paraphenelia found in the neighborhood, The committee approved the installation of three Neighborhood Watch signs located at:

Wyandotte and Fallbrook

Royer and Sherman Way

Near the footbridge at the end of Royer.

The motion was made by Steve R and seconded by Faye B. The committee approved it unanimously.

2. General Discussion on any other Committee matters WHNC can provide four Disaster Preparedness kits to blocks of homes. A block must consist of at least 6 homes. The residents would have to take an hour and a half training class.
