The Committee shall take official action by a simple majority of yes and no votes cast by the committee members present at a duly noticed regular or special Streets and Transportation Committee meeting, not to include abstentions. There shall be no proxy voting.

Chair Brad Vanderhoof called the meeting to order at 7:31 PM. A quorum was established. There was no objection to Steve Randall attending virtually.

3. Comments from the Chair: None
4. Approval of September Meeting Minutes: Minutes approved.
5. General Public Comment: Visitor Jared introduced himself. He is working on his Eagle Scout project. A stakeholder mentioned a problem with illegal u-turns at Roscoe and Fallbrook. The problem occurs because of the long left turn wait time; causing drivers to turn right and make an immediate u-turn.
6. Update on Street Resurfacing: Glenn said the problems on westbound Vanowen between Lena and Woodlake have yet to be addressed.
8. Four-way Stop at Roscoe and March: During discussion, the committee decided this intersection is too close to Valley Circle for a stop at Roscoe to be effective or practical. It was thought that during rush hour traffic could back up to Valley Circle. No action taken.
9. Update on Potholes on Vanowen between Platt and Fallbrook: See item 6.
10. Request Letter Additional Bollards in West Hills: Discussion showed bollards are not very popular with committee members. No action taken.
