Chaminade College Preparatory has been operating on the current campus since 1960. Throughout the years, our campus facilities have evolved as we have continued to strive to create an enriched educational experience that provides the best opportunities for our students. To serve existing campus and student needs, we have identified a campus plan to expand our educational and athletic facilities – all of which are necessary to allow Chaminade to remain a competitive college preparatory school within the San Fernando Valley.

At a high level, our campus plan includes the construction of a pedestrian bridge across Saticoy Street to safely connect both properties, development and modernization of new and existing campus facilities, updates to existing athletic facilities, and construction of new athletic facilities on the proposed new campus located at the northwest corner of Woodlake Avenue and Saticoy Street. Although the campus plan includes updates that are necessary to relieve the burden on existing campus facilities, there will be no change in student enrollment.
