



Domestic Violence Victim Services

If you are identified by an officer from LAPD Division out of - Devonshire, Topanga or ██████████ as a victim of domestic violence, you are entitled to access certain services free of charge.

If you wish to meet with an advocate (counselor), please ask the officer who gave you this card to contact our agency to make arrangements.

An advocate may be able to assist you with:

Immediate crisis intervention and assessment:

- Counseling
- Shelter information and transportation
- Transportation for medical treatment

Information and/or resources and referrals about:

- Legal process in criminal and civil cases
- Questions about custody and visitation
- Temporary restraining orders
- Safety planning
- CalWORKs
- Victim Assistance Program
- Legal Services
- Obtain a copy of your police report
